- 1. **Biodata Page of Passport or Travel Document** with validity of no less than 6 months
- 2. **Photograph** taken within the last 6 months with a light -coloured background
- 3. Proof of Swiss nationality or permanent residence (permit C holder) in Switzerland/ Liechtenstein
- 4. Financial evidence showing monthly income of no less than 65,000 THB or having the current balance of 800,000 THB (e.g., bank statements for the last 3 months, proof of earnings)
- 5. A <u>medical certificate</u> issued in the country where the application is submitted, showing no prohibitive diseases (Leprosy, Tuberculosis, Elephantiasis, drug addiction, and third stage of Syphilis) as specified in the Ministerial Regulation No. 14 (B.E. 2535). The certificate must be valid for no more than 3 months.
- 6. Foreign Insurance Certificate, as stipulate by the Office of Insurance Commission and Health Insurance of Thailand, must be completed, signed, and stamped by the insurance company. The form can be downloaded from https://longstay.tgia.org.
- 7. **Health Insurance** issued by a Thai or foreign insurer, covering general illnesses, including COVID-19, with a minimum insured sum of 100,000 USD or 3,000,000 THB
- 8. **Certificate of criminal record clearance** issued by a local competent authority or from the country of nationality. **The certificate must be valid for no more than 3 months.**

If the applicant fails to submit all required documents or submits screenshots or unclear files, they will be asked to provide additional documents, which may delay visa processing.
